SB informed that the next **Capital Grant Scheme** opens on July 8th (for approx. 3 months). This could potentially provide funds of between 5k and 75k for Community projects such as Village Halls.

Grants awarded will only cover up to 50% of the total cost of the project To be investigated / applied for, for our Heating / Floor & pipework issues. **MA** suggested that we get the pipework (for heating) and the floor sorted first & then do the Boiler at a later date to help spread the cost.

Victoria Reading Room Memorial Fund.

SB has been in the process of closing the VRR account in order to simplify the admin of the Village Hall funds.

The sole beneficiary of the VRR is the Holton Village Hall.

The funds will be transferred to Holton Village Hall.
